

HEAD CHORISTER (August 2026)

The Head Chorister (song leader) is appointed by the nominations committee for a one-year term. He will provide a schedule and direction for our acapella song leaders and acapella singing. Head Chorister shall be accountable to the Ministers.

Song selections to be used are typically from our hymnals and should reflect the theme of the Sunday School lesson or the morning Sermon.

Responsibilities:

- Prepare a schedule for individual song leaders who are CMF members in charge of singing for each Sunday morning service.
- If the scheduled song leader is sick or calls off on short notice, be prepared to be the replacement chorister for that event or find a replacement.
- Select qualified song leaders for acapella singing. (i.e., proficient at finding the proper key, accurately beating time, good voice projection, and continuing the song in the proper key).
- Song leaders shall display Godly enthusiasm in their leading style.
- Head Chorister shall be available for other joint CMF events such as business meetings, common small group gatherings, bi-annual Communion, baptism, Sunday evening services, revivals and weekend meetings.
- Head Chorister is responsible for scheduling the bi-monthly acapella worship singing which replaces our normal worship time. This should be coordinated with the Head Worship Leader.
- Identify & train new prospective song leaders as needed, and for the future.
